3) Maximum Participants: 30 for international students.

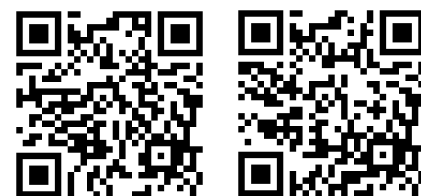
4) Registration and inquiry:
