


Graduate School of Agricultural Science participates in the following two programs.

©Global HAGI Scholarship

Since 2018, this scholarship has fostered "leaders capable of creativity and innovation" who will contribute to scientific and technological development in Japan by offering scholarships to exceptional students who possess an abundance of both motivations to study at Tohoku University and talent, while providing an environment in which they can continue to the doctoral curriculum and dedicate themselves to academic research. From FY 2022, the scholarship will be expanded to include students in master's curricula.

• Support contents : 600,000 yen/Year (Equivalent to tuition fee). The support period is for four years (M2, D1, D2, D3). %If the student is adopted at D1, the support period is for three years.

 \cdot Application qualification : M2 or D1 students

◎JASSO Scholarship(Loan-based scholarship) ※Basically only for Japanese students (On-campus website) <u>https://www2.he.tohoku.ac.jp/shogaku/gaiyo.html</u>

*There is also a refund waiver system for those who achieve outstanding performance during the loan period.

◎Long-term registration system (for Adult students) ※Not everyone is eligible to apply.

This is a system to extend the standard term of study mainly for those who are full-time employees of companies, etc., or those who are engaged in childbirth, childcare, nursing care, etc. If you wish, please be sure to apply <u>at the time of enrollment</u>.

Example: The standard term of study for the Doctoral program is three years, but if you extend your enrollment to six years using this long-term enrollment system, you can enroll for six years for the equivalent of three years' tuition fee (535,800 yen per year x 3 years = 1,607,400 yen). If you don't use the long-term enrollment system, the tuition fee for 6 years (535,800 yen per year x 6 years = 3,214,800 yen) will be required.

These programs are a new financial aid program for doctoral students starting in the academic year 2021. The program aims to improve the environment for study and research by eliminating financial concerns about entering a doctoral program and career paths after obtaining a doctoral degree.

Support contents: [Pioneering Research Support Project] (JST's) and [Doctoral Fellowship] (MEXT's)
 <u>Monthly stipend (JPY 180,000 (standard amount))</u> + <u>Research grant (JPY 340,000 per year)</u>

*Both of these programs have restrictions on duplicate payments and obligations of the recipient, so please check the website or the application guidelines for details.

 Application qualification:1st-year Doctoral Program student (including those who enrolled in October 2021) who was "Master student of DIARE" or who is especially excellent in terms of grades, research, imagination, etc. except for "Master student of DIARE". <u>*October enrollment students are eligible</u> to apply.

• Support contents: <u>Scholarships 200,000 yen/Month</u> (equivalent to the JSPS (Japan Society for the Promotion of Science) research fellowship for young scientists (DC)), <u>Research grant 500,000 yen/Year</u>, <u>Support to network between graduate schools in order to promote interdisciplinary research activities</u>.

• Recommendable quotas from the Graduate School of Agricultural Sciences: Usually <u>5 or less</u> *Varies from the academic year.

For Doctoral Program ③

ODoctoral Support system (TA/RA)

This is the Graduate School of Agricultural Science's own financial aid system for doctoral students.

 \cdot Students are hired as TA/RA and the maximum amount of support is up to the annual tuition fee (535,800 yen).

• Applications are accepted twice a year. The maximum amount of support per half year is 267,900 yen.

• In principle, doctoral students who have exceeded the standard period of study are not eligible for support. However, students who exceed the standard years of study due to special circumstances such as childbirth, childcare, or nursing care may be eligible for support.

[Recruitment period] ** Announced by the Student Affairs Information System and email to professors. First semester: Early April \sim Middle April Second semester: Early September \sim Middle Semester
