1 Enrollment Registration

(2) Tuition Fee: JPY 267,900 for 1st semester. JPY 535,800 for one year.

※MEXT Scholarship students do not need to pay tuition fee.

The tuition fee will be paid by automatic withdrawal from your bank account or from an account of a person who gives you financial support. To register your bank account for the withdrawal, all students are required to apply for the bank transfer request, regardless of whether you apply for the tuition fee waiver or not.

7 Other payments

(1) Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research ("Gakkensai") and Liability Insurance coupled with Gakkensai ("Gakkenbai")

To ensure a safe and secure campus life, it is essential to be fully prepared for unexpected accidents and injuries. Starting from April 2026, Tohoku University has decided to cover the insurance premiums for all new undergraduate, graduate, and transfer students for the following two types of insurance. Enrollment is mandatory and will be processed by the university.

① Gakkensai (Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research)

This insurance provides necessary benefits for injuries sustained by the student during regular curricular activities, school events, while on university premises, during extracurricular (club) activities, or while commuting to and from the university.

② Gakkenbai (Liability Insurance coupled with Gakkensai)

This insurance covers legal liability for damages in the event that the student injures others or damages the property of others during regular curricular activities, school events, extracurricular activities such as volunteer clubs, or while traveling to and from these activities.

(2) <<For International Students Only>> Enrollment in "Inbound Futai Gakuso"

Inbound Futai Gakuso (TYPE B): 20,130 yen (for 2 years)

Inbound Futai Gakuso (TYPE E): 26,190 yen (for 2 years)

Note: The coverage details differ between TYPE B and TYPE E. The university does not specify which type to choose, so please select the one that best suits your needs.

"Gakkensai" is a system designed to provide relief for various accidents students may encounter during commuting, education, research, and extracurricular activities. "Inbound Futai Gakuso" (Comprehensive Insurance for Students' Lives Coupled with Gakkensai for International Students) is an insurance policy that covers injuries, illnesses, and accidents occurring throughout your daily life in Japan. To prepare for emergencies, Tohoku University requires all international students to enroll in this insurance.

Payment Method:

Please register online via the QR code provided in the materials posted on our website, and pay the premium at a convenience store. After payment, please submit a copy of the receipt during the admission procedures.

(3) The Suisaikai(農学部翠生会)

The Suisaikai is an organization that aims to promote friendship among the staff and students of the Faculty of Agriculture, and to promote mutual cultural and athletic development, and to improve the quality of life of its members. The details of the membership fee will be announced after admission.

(4) Tohoku University Fund, Tohoku University Alumni Association, Tohoku University Shuyukai

The guide will be provided at the graduate school newcomer orientation.

8. Long-term course system.

Students who wish to apply for the Long-term Course System must apply at this time. No further applications will be accepted after enrollment.

The Graduate School of Agricultural Science has introduced a long-term course system for students who are unable to devote themselves to their studies due to work or family obligations.

Those who are eligible for this system are those who fall into one of the following categories and are recognized as having difficulty completing the program within the standard two-year period of study.

- (1) Those who have a job (full-time employees of a company, etc. or those who run their own business)
- (2) Those who need to give birth, raise children, or take care of family members.
- (3) Other reasons for applying are approved by the Graduate School of Agricultural Science

To apply for this system, please consult with your expected supervisor, prepare a course plan, and submit the Application for Long-Term Course system (Attachment Form 1) with your expected supervisor's opinion at the time of admission procedures. The Graduate School will review the application and decide whether it is acceptable or not.

The period of study cannot exceed 4 years, but a request for shortening of the approved period of study may be made.

The total amount of tuition payment is the same as that for students who have completed the standard years of study.
